

Reception Class 2019 Open Day and Open Day for parents & carers of children currently in reception Class



Saint of the Week

Saturday is the Feast Day of St Martin de Porres. He is a saint I hold in particular affection as my parents gave me the middle name of Martin in his honour; I also had a statue of St Martin in my bedroom when I was growing up. St Martin was born in Lima, Peru during the time of Spanish rule. As he was of black African heritage, many of the opportunities that were open to Peruvians of Spanish descent were not afforded to him. He devoted his whole life to the service of others—people and animals. He actually ran a hospital for cats and dogs at his sister's house. He was a Dominican brother throughout his adulthood and is held in high esteem by members of that order to this day.
