New parent email parents@holyfamily.essex.sch.uk We are pleased to advise that, with effect from the Autumn term, parents and carers will have access to a dedicated email address in order to contact the school for example to report pupil absence; advise on different pick –up arrangements or other important matters. The email account will be monitored by the ladies in the office on a daily basis.

Preparation for First Holy Communion Preparation for this Sacrament will commence in mid to late September and finishes in the following June with a Thanksgiving Mass and celebration. The course is open to eligible children in school year 3 (from September 2017) and above. The children’s sessions are usually once a month and weekly attendance at the Sunday Mass (or Saturday Evening) is a prerequisite of the course. Please check the church newsletter for details of meetings with Fr. Eduard and how to apply for the course. (***Mrs Herridge***)

School Uniform I expect that all children will return to school in September with the correct school uniform, including black shoes—not trainers. If the weather is still pleasant in September, your child can return in summer or winter uniform. You will be notified when summer uniform is no longer allowed to be worn. If you are going to buy a coat for your child for

the autumn and winter, please remember that our school uniform policy (which all parents agreed to when they chose to send their child to Holy Family) clearly states that plain black or navy coats should be worn at school. Please don't put your child in an awkward situation by sending them to school in red polka dots or combat camouflage, as they will be asked where their school coat is.

Drum lessons There is one space for a child to take up drum lessons in the Autumn term. At a cost of £75 per term, children receive 10 lessons of 15 minutes during the school day with a qualified tutor from Essex Music Services. (Vouchers are available for a 66% subsidy of the fees if the child comes from a low-income family. Applications for vouchers are made via tuition.vouchers@essex.gov.uk)If you are interested in the drum place, please contact Mrs Duxbury in the school office. The place will be allocated on a 'first come first served' basis with a waiting list after that.

School dinners for Juniors A reminder to Year 2 parents that when your child enters Year 3, you are required to pay for school dinners at a cost of £2.20 in advance or on the day.
