Saint of the week St Maria Giuseppe Rossello, feast day (7th December) was the Foundress of the Daughters of Our Lady of Mercy. She was born at in Liguria, Italy, in 1811, and was baptised Benedetta. At the age of sixteen she became a Franciscan tertiary, and in 1837, she and three companions founded a community in Savona. The congregation was devoted to charitable works, hospitals, and educating poor young women. In 1840, Maria Giuseppe, also called Josepha, was made superior. By the time she died on December 7, 1888, she had made sixty-eight foundations. She was canonised in 1949.
