I hope that you all had a relaxing half term in the sunshine with your families. As promised in our last newsletter, here are some pictures from the recent Crowning of Our Lady service.



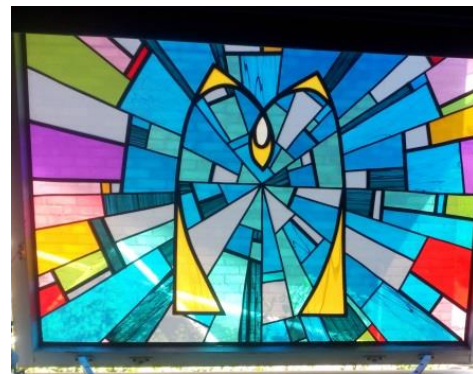
We began the new half term with a Pentecost assembly and delicious birthday cakes made by Mrs Willis which were distributed around the whole school.

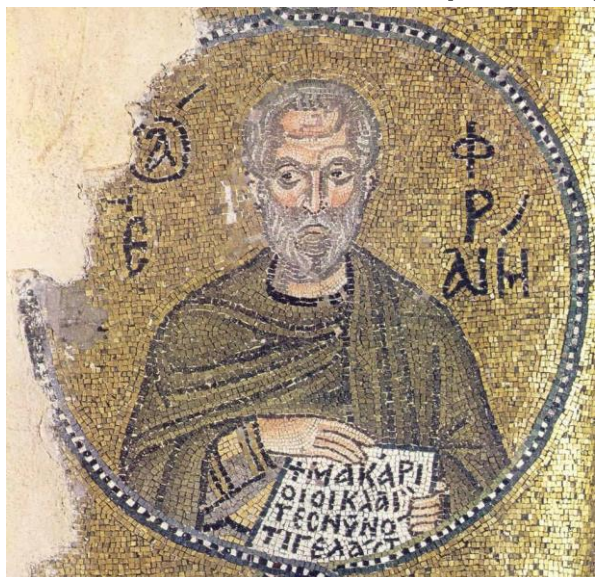

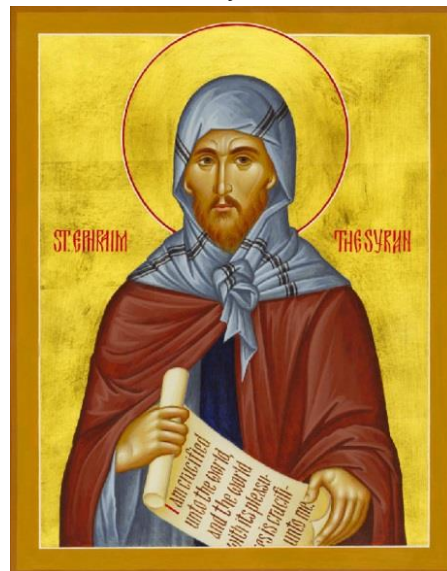

**Saint of the Week** I was going to write about St Anthony of Padua—the patron saint of lost things. However, after listening to Fr Eduard’s sermon this morning, I feel obliged to write a few lines in honour of St Ephrem the Syrian. Fr Eduard told us about the rich Christian heritage of Syria and how St Ephrem wrote many beautiful poems, verses and hymns—Fr Eduard quoted to us from one of the poems. St Ephrem was born in 306 and grew up speaking a version of Aramaic, the language that Jesus would have spoken. He is still revered in many Christian lands and is known as the “*Harp of the Spirit*.” Catholics mark his Feast Day on 9<sup>th</sup> June.
